LAW COURT REPORTS

WIFE REFUSES TO GIVE EVIDENCE IN SHOOTING CASE

A man charged with shooting at and attempting to murder a woman in 1956 was now happily married to her, Parramatta Court of Quarter Sessions was told yesterday.

Benjamin Hughie Edwards, 42, shearer, was charged with shooting at Gwendoline Elsie Bracken and Constable Glen Selby Harold Graham with intent to murder, or alternatively to do grievous bodily harm, at Mt. Victoria, on December 2, 1956.

Edwards pleaded not guilty. Edwards' wife, Gwendoline Elsie Edwards, formerly Bracken, refused to give evidence.

In a statement from the dock, Edwards said he had married Miss Bracken soon after the incident. He asked to be allowed to return home to his wife and child.

Constable Graham told the Court he was outside a flat where Edwards lived in Mon-

tague Street, Mt. Victoria, on December 2. Miss Bracken was standing nearby. A bullet passed between them and hit his car.

Miss Bracken jumped away and fell on the ground and remained there.

Constable Graham said he saw a rifle barrel poking out through lattice-work on the flats about 18 yards away.

He took shelter on the other side of his car, drew his service revolver, and called on the defendant to come out.

A .22 rifle was then thrown to the ground and Edwards came out of the flats with his hands up. He smelt strongly of intoxicating liquor.

Edwards had said: "I am sorry. I didn't mean to shoot you. I just meant to threaten you."

Detective-Constable Denis Brian Fethers, of Penrith, said Edwards told him he had accused Miss Bracken of interest in other men.

Miss Bracken had called Constable Graham to the house to stop Edwards drinking.

Edwards had told him he had fired the rifle downwards to avoid hitting the constable or Miss Bracken.

Detective-Constable Fethers said Edwards told him: "I am known around White Cliffs and Wilcannia as a crack shot with a .22. I used to shoot rabbits 20 yards away on the run."

"If I had meant to shoot Gwennie or Constable Graham I don't see how I could have missed."

Detective-Constable Ernest Ross Nickson, police ballistics expert, told the Court the rifle could be fired accidentally because of the light trigger pressure.

The hearing was adjourned until today.

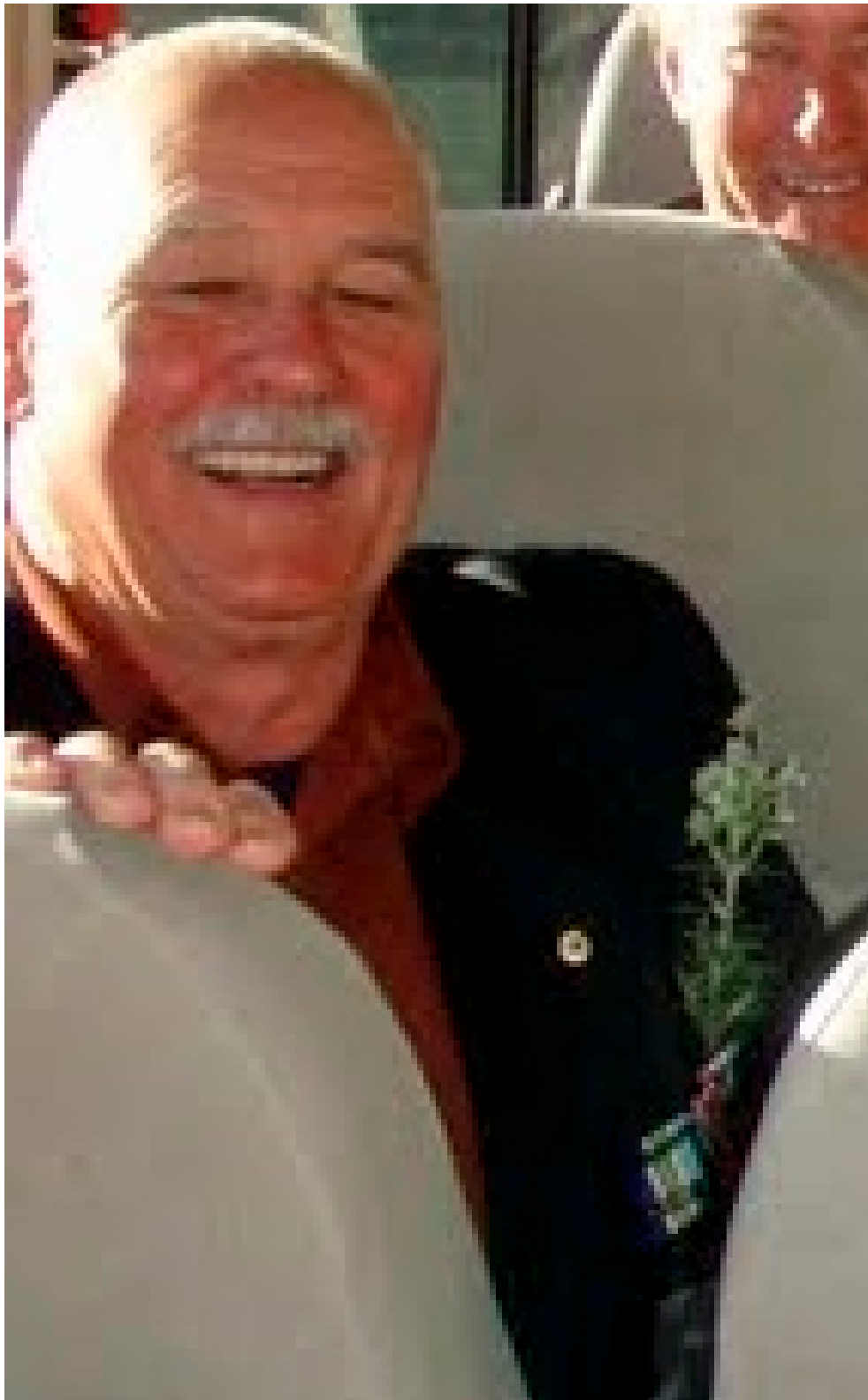

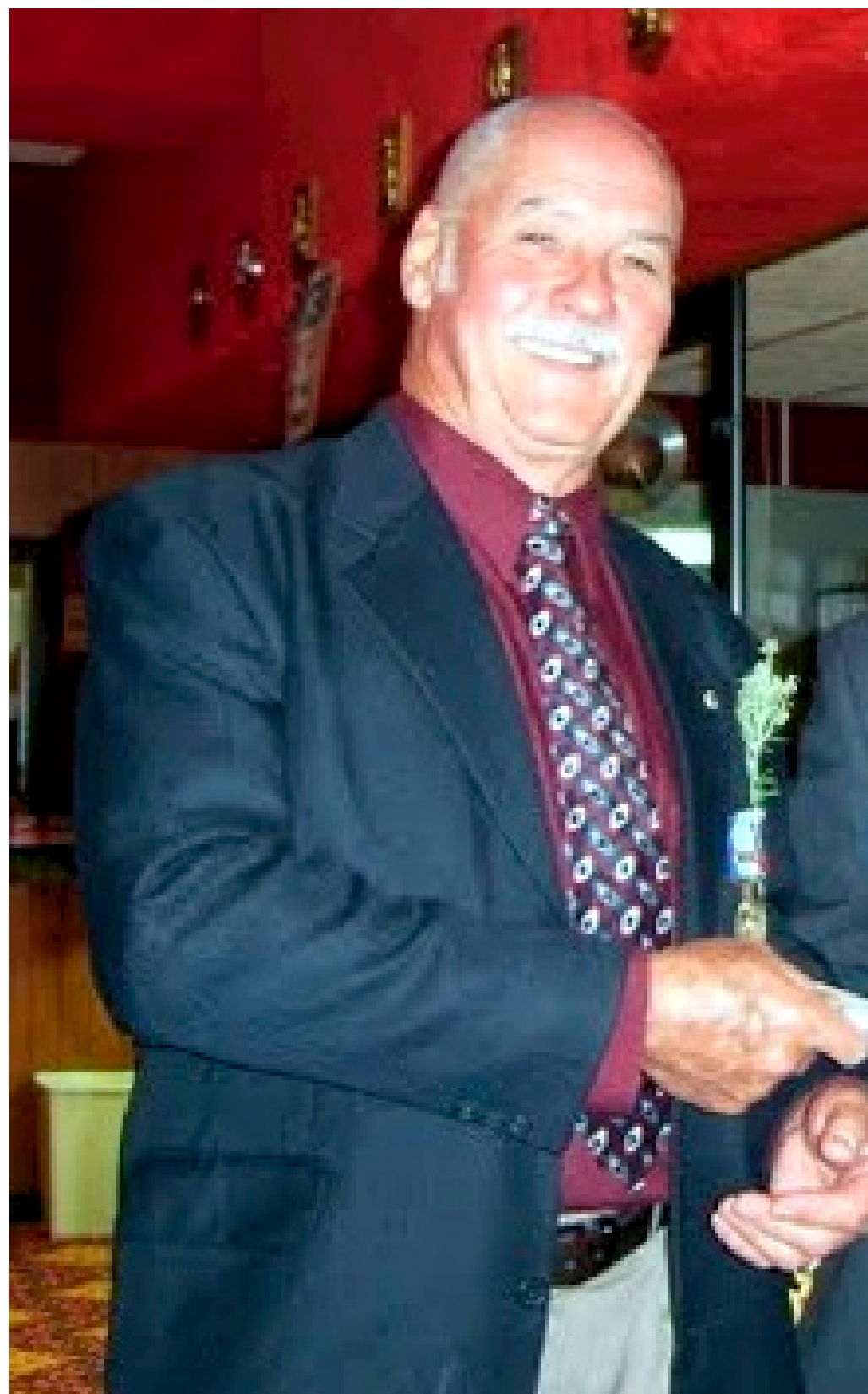

Bull Terrier Attack On Heart Patient

A bull terrier dog charged and attacked a 63-year-old man as he was strolling along a South Coast beach on Monday afternoon.

The attack occurred just one day after baby Joshua Williams was mauled to death by his family's pet bull terrier in the backyard of their North Richmond home.

In the latest attack, Mr Leonard Crane was forced to use his walking stick to fend off the dog which charged at him from 40 metres on Collingwood Beach at Jervis Bay shortly before 5.30pm.

Sergeant Barry Passlow from Nowra police said Mr Crane was not injured by the dog but was extremely distressed by the attack.

"He had recently undergone heart surgery and his doctors had said: 'no stress'. This was just what he didn't need," Sergeant Passlow said.

The white bull terrier was one of two unleashed dogs which arrived on the beach with a man and a woman as Mr Crane was taking a stroll.

Sergeant Passlow said the woman called the dog off Mr Crane, but she and the man with her refused to give Mr Crane their names.

Sergeant Passlow said the dogs were supposed to be restrained on leashes and police were making inquiries to try to find the owners.

The Federal Government is expected to announce within three weeks a ban on the import of dangerous dogs.
