Police awarded study grants

Four police officers from NSW, Queensland, Tasmania and the Australian Federal Police are to receive grants for overseas study, the Minister for Administrative Services, Mr McLeay, announced yesterday.

The grants, worth \$5,000 each, are the first to be awarded under a special study grants scheme, open to police throughout Australia. They will be awarded annually.

The successful applicants are **Sergeant First Class Lionel Duff Kellock**, NSW, Senior Sergeant Francis Michael Rynne, Queensland, Sergeant First Grade Ronald John Martin, Tasmania and Inspector Alan John Sing, Australian Federal Police (Sydney).

Sergeant Martin will go overseas to research methods of detection and investigation of arson incidents. Senior

Sergeant Rynne will research the nature and scope of police training and education. **Sergeant Kellock** will study **police internal affairs** and investigation in overseas police forces.

Inspector Sing will use his grant to research social, judicial and legislative attitudes and trends and consequent

relationships to human rights, the law of arrest, ; the law of search and seizure and the admissibility of self-incriminating evidence.



PCYC Lismore gets a cool upgrade

The Lismore PCYC will soon have temperature control in their primary exercise areas thanks to a new air conditioning system and purpose fitted doors.

The PCYC will receive \$50,261 in funding from the NSW Government to undertake the upgrades.

With hundreds of people from the local community accessing the facility each week, they will now be able to exercise in greater comfort.

Nationals Member of the Legislative Council Ben Franklin said the upgrades were needed to make sure the PCYC could continue offering great facilities to the community.

“The Lismore PCYC is a really important place for schools, local clubs and groups, but most importantly, it is a safe place for young people to go, particularly those who are most vulnerable,” Mr Franklin said.

“Upgrading the facilities will mean they can be accessed more frequently and youth programs can be expanded to continue looking after vulnerable and at-risk youth in the local community.

“Ensuring that the facilities are modern also makes sure the wider community can enjoy the PCYC year round and support their wellbeing.”

The increased usability of the PCYC will mean the Club can focus on increasing the capacity of young people to come together, increase their divisionary and Aboriginal youth

programs and expand NSW Police youth case management with disadvantaged young people.

Mr Greg Ironfield, Club Manager at the Lismore PCYC said this was great news for the Club.

“We’re very excited to receive funding through the Stronger Country Communities Fund,” Mr Ironfield said.

“We will be utilising the funds to upgrade our Club facilities, including adding air conditioning to our gym, martial arts and boxing rooms.”

“We will also be enhancing and expanding our Police Rise Up Programs to reach more young people in our community.”

Air conditioning and purpose-fitted doors will be installed to the gym, the martial arts room and the boxing room.

Replacing the current barred doors with more appropriate sealable doors will mean temperature regulation is possible and will provide for sustainable use of electricity through heating and cooling.

Youth hub for Lismore

A COP, a musician and a social worker have teamed up to help fill a gap for young people in the Lismore community.

Hip-hop artist Blake "Teddy" Rhodes jumped at the chance to collaborate with Senior Constable Lachlan Bransgrove and Francis O'Neill of Social Futures to launch a youth night initiative through the Police Citizens Youth Club.

When he was a teenager growing up in Lismore, Mr Rhodes through his friends

discovered an after-school youth connections group, which he said had helped shape the musician and person he is today.

He said the initiative led to a great place to hang out with his mates and equipped him with life skills such as learning how to cook.

"Lismore definitely needs something sort of like what I had back in the day," Mr Rhodes said. "I was one of those kids who fell into those bad habits until I found youth connections."

Snr Const Bransgrove said the hub would be crucial to

reducing anti-social behaviour around Lismore by providing various activities to engage youth.

"It (the hub) is about trying to find something that they can get involved in, trying to find something that takes them away from needing to do that kind of behaviour because they have an outlet somewhere else," Sr Const Bransgrove said.

Mr Rhodes, who also mentors school students and holds workshops around the community, wants to engage with Lismore's youth.

He said the combined

experience of the three men would create a constructive avenue to guide and support Lismore's young people through their teens.

Snr Const Bransgrove said setbacks such as the March flood had pushed back the launch of the hub.

Mr O'Neill said last week that he and Sr Const Bransgrove had started visiting high schools to "get the word out" about the hub and ask what youth wanted from the initiative.

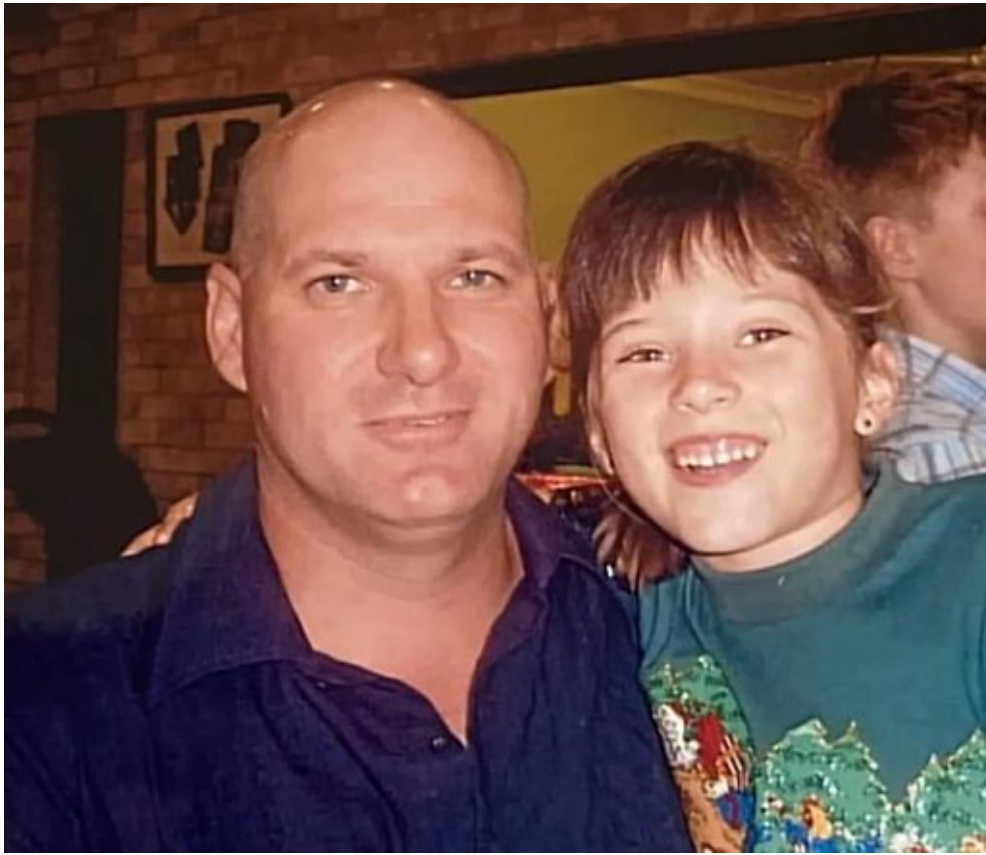

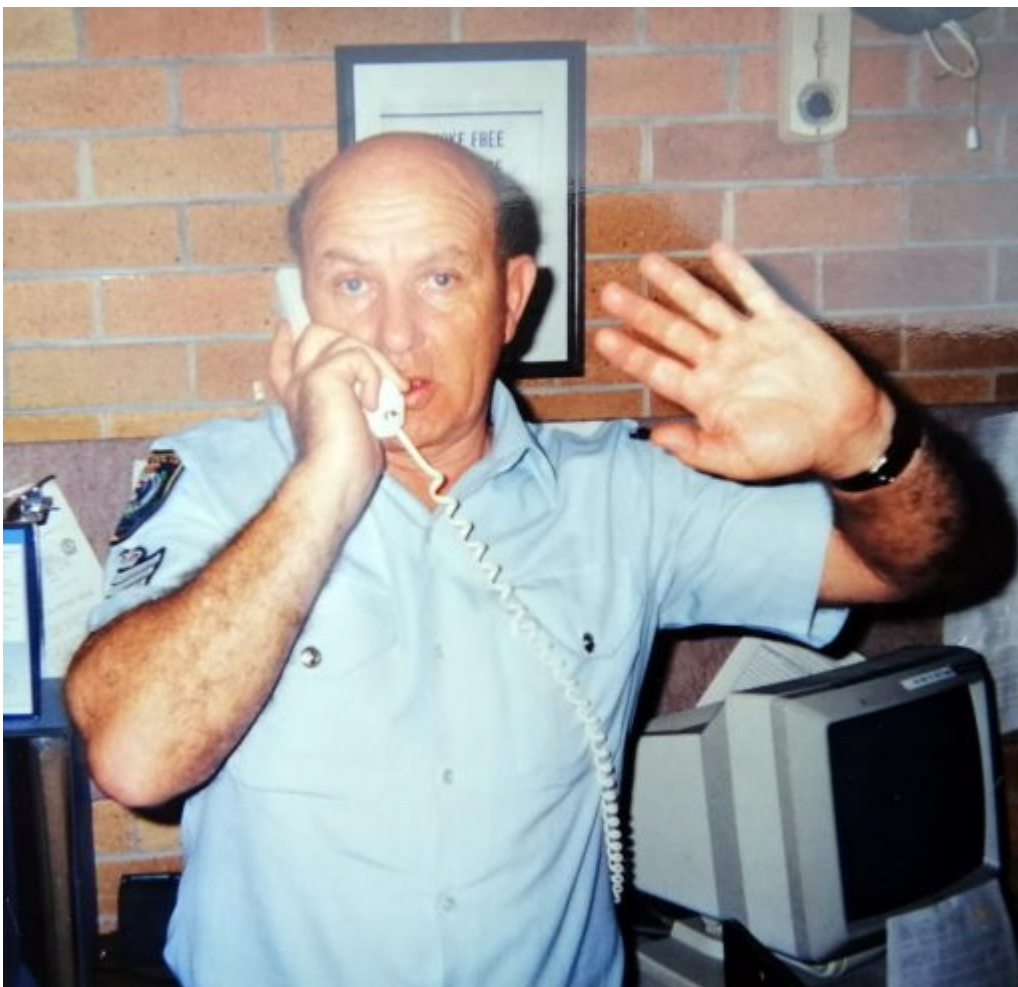

18 AWARDS MADE FOR BRAVE CONDUCT

Drowned rescuer earns medal

Mr **Daniel Primmer**, who drowned after becoming snagged in debris while trying to rescue a woman trapped by flood waters in **Reedy Creek, ACT**, on **March 20** last year, has been awarded a **Bravery Medal posthumously**.

Mr **Primmer** was one of six people to be awarded the Bravery Medal for their part in rescuing the woman.

Altogether, 18 awards for bravery were announced yesterday by the Governor-General, Sir Zelman Cowen, on recommendations made to him by the Australian Decorations Advisory Committee. Thirteen Bravery Medals and five Commendations for Brave Conduct were awarded.

The rescue attempt at **Reedy Creek** took place where **the stream crosses Sutton Road**, near **Queanbeyan**.

A car driven by Mrs **Rosanna Perry**, 33, of **Bungendore**, was swept off a bridge by the flood waters.

Mr **Primmer** and a companion, Mr **John Henjack**, who also has been awarded the **Bravery Medal**, tied themselves with rope secured to a guide post and held by five men, and attempted to swim to the woman.

The two were swept away before they could reach her, and although Mr. **Henjack** was pulled to safety, Mr **Primmer** became snagged in debris, and drowned.

Sergeant Alwyne Hill and **Senior Constable Robert Burrage**, of the NSW Police, who were also involved in the rescue attempt, have been awarded Bravery Medals. With other police officers, they made three attempts to reach the stranded woman, using a rope, which failed, and then made several attempts to swim to her.

Mr **Robert Perrott**, of **Bungendore**, who also entered the flood waters but was swept away and managed to reach the bank downstream, has also been awarded the Bravery Medal.

Senior Constable Brian Bock, of the **ACT Police**, received a **Commendation for Brave Conduct** in the rescue attempt. He took charge of a NSW Emergency Service boat which eventually he manoeuvred close enough to rescue the woman.

Mr **Ronald Scott**, Mr **Graham MacDonald** and Mr **Kenneth Beazley**, all of Malua Bay, NSW, were each awarded a Bravery Medal for their actions during the successful rescue of three people stranded on a rocky outcrop after they had lost their boat in heavy seas.

On September 18, 1977, the three rescuers had put to sea from Guerilla Bay, and in the face of a souther'y gale reached the three people whose boat had become disabled, been washed up on the rocks and destroyed.

Mr MacDonald had jumped from the rescue boat, and persuaded the stranded people to swim to the boat, where they were all picked up and returned safely to shore.

Mr Scott, the owner of the rescue boat, was praised for his handling of the boat. Mr Beazley's award said that "in taking part in a sea rescue in such hazardous conditions" he had displayed considerable courage.

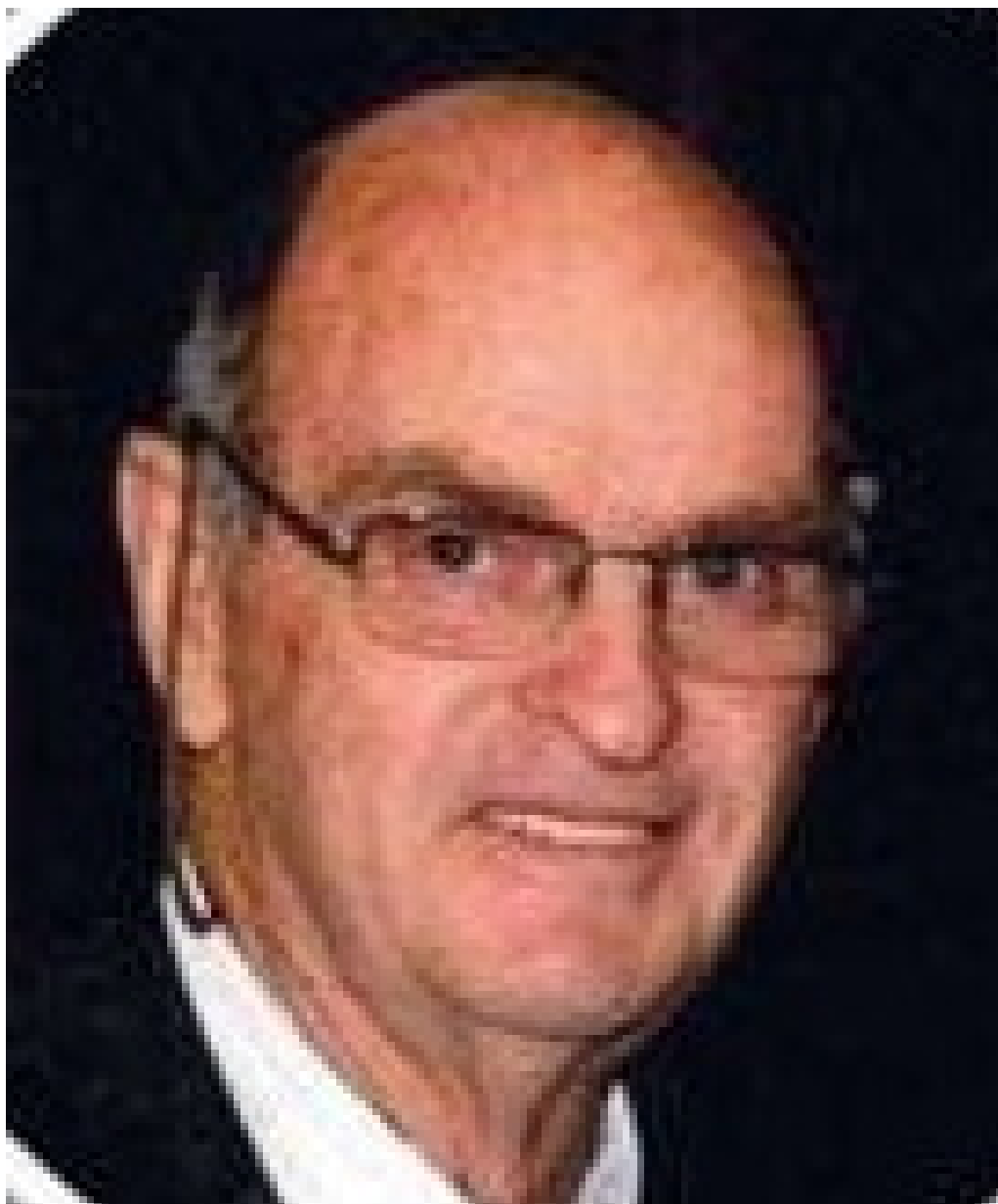
